#### **Presidential Award for Professional Development of Probationary Faculty**

**Applications Due: November 5, 2018** 

The Office of Faculty Affairs is pleased to announce that probationary faculty in years two, three, and four are eligible to apply for a Presidential Award for Professional Development of Probationary Faculty. The purpose of this award is to support the retention, tenure and promotion of probationary faculty who demonstrate an active engagement with their individual field of study. Awards are competitive and will be granted on the basis of proposals which demonstrate the ability of the faculty member to accomplish the project within the time-frame of the award, the significance of the activity, the clarity of the proposal, and the need for the award. Faculty will receive all benefits and service-years credit.

#### **GUIDELINES**

Awards are for one semester with full pay.

Awards are intended to support the retention, tenure and promotion of probationary faculty who are actively engaged with their individual fields of study.

The award will be negated if tenure is granted.

Faculty are eligible to receive only one award during their probationary years.

The evaluation of Presidential Awards will be based on activities which enhance professional achievement and growth. Faculty will receive all benefits and service-years credit towards sabbatical and tenure governed by Articles 13 and 27 of the Agreement.

#### **CRITERIA**

To apply, faculty must be in their second, third, or fourth probationary year. The leave will be taken in the subsequent third, fourth, or fifth probationary year. Among applicants, faculty for whom their appointment at San Francisco State University is their first position as an Assistant Professor and faculty who have more recently received their terminal degree will be given preference.

#### **PROCEDURE**

Deans will notify eligible probationary faculty of the availability of awards and the procedures for application. Applications must be submitted to the school deans who, after appropriate consultation, will send 2 ranked recommendations to the President.

The President will review the ranked recommendations and make his decision for the awards.

Final approval of the Presidential Award for Professional Development of Probationary Faculty will not be granted until the applicant has filed with the University a suitable bond indemnifying the State of California against loss in the event the faculty member fails to render one semester of service for each semester of leave in the California State University following the leave of absence as indicated in the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

#### BOND WAIVER/WAIVER OF BOND

All leave with pay recipients must post a bond in the amount of the salary to be paid during the leave or, more commonly, obtain a waiver of the bond. The waivers of bond must be notarized. If you are awarded a leave, you must submit this documentation within 6 weeks of the notification of the award.
